







Following announcements from the Premier over the weekend about further restrictions, the goal posts have changed again for schools as the situation becomes more and more serious each day.

As of NOW, the department has provided stronger advice for parents and carers about keeping their child at home wherever possible, asking schools to forward the following message to all parents:

"Parents MUST keep children - of all ages, across primary and secondary schooling and early childcare - home if they can. Students will be supported to learn from home. Schools and early childhood education and care services, including Out Of School Hours Care services are open for any child that needs it. Thank you for your support."

Further to this, all school Principals have been directed to ensure that only the minimum number of staff are on site at any time to ensure that the school can function. This is to ensure our staff and their families remain safe.

It has been recommended that this should be in the range of 2-5 staff members each day. It has been stressed that the maximum number of staff (including teaching, administration and support staff) on site should be 5.

If you are working from home, it is expected that your child will learn from home using the online learning program. If you intend on sending your child this week on any day, please email your class teacher or phone the office.
