#### Response protocols for COVID-19 cases

There has been a recent increase in the number of COVID cases in the Central Coast and local community. Any positive COVID-19 cases should be reported to the school if they have attended the school recently. Students, staff and visitors should only attend school when symptom free. Our school will continue to send home students or staff displaying symptoms.

NSW Health and the Department of Education encourage all students and staff who test positive to COVID-19 to record the positive rapid antigen test (RAT) through the Service NSW website Register a positive rapid antigen test result | NSW Government or Service NSW app Service NSW Mobile App | Service NSW. Parents and carers are asked to select the name of the school when registering a positive RAT via Service NSW.

Positive RAT or PCR test results for staff and students should be reported to the school. Refer to NSW Health's advice for people who test positive to COVID-19 <u>Testing positive to COVID-19</u> and managing COVID-19 safely at home | NSW Government and Advice for people exposed to COVID-19 Advice for people exposed to COVID-19 | NSW Government for further information.

Kariong Public School will continue to inform the community when there is a positive case in the school. If there is a positive case in your child's class, year or other grouping, your child can continue to attend school in line with NSW Health advice.



The students were worn out at the end of the day and some had a quiet sleep in the bus. Everyone had a great day.









#### NSW Health Mobile Dental Program











#### **NSW Health Primary School Dental Program**

NSW Health is working with public primary schools to offer <u>free dental check-ups</u> and preventive care to students as part of a school-based mobile dental program. Your child's school has been selected to participate in this program.

The program involves a mobile dental team making scheduled visits to your child's primary school. During the first appointment a dental check-up and preventive care package will be provided, subject to parental consent. A letter will be sent to parents/guardians providing an update on the child's dental check-up.

The program is scheduled to visit your child's school from 6/02/2023 to 22/02/2023.

Parent Information and Consent Packs will be sent home, including information sheets, consent forms and the program privacy statement. Parents/guardians who want their child to receive care are advised to:

- 1. Read all the information provided
- 2. Carefully complete the consent forms
- 3. Return the consent forms to the school as soon as possible




From July 2019, children attending participating primary schools in The Central Coast will have access to free dental care through the NSW Health Primary School Mobile Dental Program.

#### **Online Enrolment**

We are excited to announce the roll out of the new Online Enrolment System. The Online Enrolment System is designed to provide flexibility for our parents to submit an enrolment application online and at the time that best suits you. The application can be accessed on all browsers and mobile devices including iOS and Android.

The online application process is currently restricted to:

- **Enrolments into local schools only**
- Children who are Australian citizens
- New Zealand citizens or permanent residents
- Children who live in NSW.

We offer our support and encourage you to complete your application to enrol online. If, however, you do not feel comfortable completing an application online, a paper copy will be available for collection from our front office or can be downloaded from the Department's going to a public school site.

Further information about online enrolment can be found on our school website under the 'Enrolment' tab. If you require further information, please call Kariong Public School on 02 4340 1885.

#### **Online Payments**

It is very easy for parents to make online payments to the school via a secure payment page hosted by Westpac. Payments can be made using either a Visa, MasterCard credit or debit card, and can be made via computer, tablet or mobile phone. This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/ debit card details are captured in a secure manner; these details are not passed back to the school. The DoE preferred method for all money coming into the school is the Payment On-Line facility (POP) through the school's website: Kariong-p.school@det. nsw.edu.au

#### **Item categories**

If a POP payment is made before 6pm, your payment will be processed on the next day's school statement.

- If it is made after 6pm, the school will be notified two days later.
- Please ensure that on your child's permisnote, you fill in the section for POP which will require the receipt number.
- At the bottom of every note that requires payment, there is a section for cash, cheque, and Payment On Line, for your convenience.
- Please do not make payments for uniforms on this site. The Uniform Shop is privately run and their website for ordering is: gtschool.com.au.

#### **Helpful Hints**

Items that can be paid include voluntary school contributions, subject contributions, excursions, sales to students and creative and practical arts activities (these include band, drama and dance). There is also a category called 'Other' to cover items not covered in the previous headings, 'Other' can be used to make a complete payment of a school Statement of Account.

When you access the \$ Make a payment you must enter:

- the student's namedate of birth

These details are entered each time you make a payment as student information is not held within the payment system.


You have the ability to check and change any details of the payment before the payment is processed. Receipts can be emailed and/or printed.
