Nutrition Snippet 10 Tips to Encourage Children to Eat Vegies



- 1. Set a good example! Children are more likely to eat vegies if Mum and Dad are having them.
- It may take 10 20 tastes before your child will accept a new vegie, so keep on trying.
- Start with sweeter vegies such as pumpkin, carrot, capsicum and snow peas.
- Include a new vegie as part of a favourite meal or alongside familiar ones.
- 5. Let kids choose a new vegie they would like to try.
- Offer vegetables raw before introducing them cooked. Some kids prefer vegies raw.
- 7. Share vegie eating tips with other parents.
- 8. Place a salad or some extra vegetables on the table at meal time for self-selection.
- 9. Grate or finely chop vegies into bolognaise sauce, meat loaves or mild curries/casseroles.
- Throw a couple of handfuls of baby spinach into sauces, meat loaves or mild curries/ casseroles.
