## NRMA Science & Road Safety Day - Monday 5 May, 2014

Next year our school will be taking part in a new and innovative road safety education program delivered by NRMA Motoring & Services free of charge to 100 primary schools across NSW and ACT.

The day is a great opportunity for your children to learn about safety from a science perspective so that they can better understand the forces that act on humans while in cars and on bikes and why wearing safety gear, such as seatbelts and bike helmets, make a real difference to their safety.
