VALID Science & Technology 6

The Learning, High Performance & Accountability Directorate of the Department of Education is developing an online multimedia interactive assessment in Science and Technology for Year 6 students. This new assessment is part of ongoing work to expand available resources for assessing a broader range of student learning. The test, based on the model of the current Essential Secondary Science Assessment program for Year 8, will provide teachers, schools and parents with diagnostic information about student achievement and their levels of understanding. The *VALID Science & Technology 6* test will also assist teachers in planning and programming for the new Science syllabus.

As part of the program's development our Year 6 students participated in the pilot of this new assessment. This term they completed a one hour online Science and Technology test which had videos, audio and graphics during weeks 4 and 5. Our teachers then completed online professional learning prior to marking the responses from our students. The results are expected in mid-December.
