Sunscreen at school

All children are expected to be in summer school uniform this term and this includes the school approved hat and black shoes (except on sport days). When the warmer weather arrives many children put on sunscreen after they get dressed in the morning. Please note: students are allowed to bring their own sunscreen to school (if it needs to be reapplied) but they are not allowed to share it with others.

Working with Children Checks

The Working with Children Check is designed to ensure that people working in schools have met the relevant requirements under the Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012 and Child Protection (Working with Children) Regulation 2013. In addition, all employees within the Department of Education are required to meet the National Criminal Records Check.

Paid employees of the school's P&C who are working in the school are also required to complete the relevant requirements under the Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012 and Child Protection (Working with Children) Regulation 2013. This information is then provided to the Principal.

Volunteers, who provide religious instruction through our scripture program, are required to complete the relevant requirements. Each religious organisation collects this information and then confirms in writing to the principal of the school that each person has met the relevant requirements

Volunteers in our schools, including those volunteering for the P&C, are required to complete a Working with Children Check Declaration and show proof of identify that meets the 100-point check. A copy of the declaration can be obtained from the office. A completed copy is then provided to the school office by the volunteer. Once this is completed any volunteer in the school **must wear a visitor badge** indicating that all checks have been made.

Staff Developments Days

At the end of the year schools are allocated two Staff Development Days. At Kariong PS staff decided to hold these days earlier in the year instead of at the end of the year. All staff were involved in four afternoon professional learning sessions from 3.30 - 6.30 pm. This means the last day of school for teachers will be the same day as for students.

The last day of school for students is Friday 16 December. School resumes in 2017 for all Year 1-6 students on Monday 30 January. Kindergarten students start on Thursday 1 February.



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Classes for 2017

During the coming weeks, staff will be looking at the formation of classes for 2017. The placing of children into their new classes each year is a complex process. Classes at Kariong Public School are not graded academically and each year we strive to ensure that we have well balanced classes. The following factors are considered;

Gender, Academic ability, Language needs, Medical needs, Cultural background, and Behavioural needs

When this has occurred we try to ensure that each child has at least one friend in their new class. Later in the term children will be asked to nominate 5 children who they would like to be placed with. The school will try to place each student with at least one of these children. This does not mean they will be placed with their best or closest friend or with their group of friends. In fact, often this is not appropriate.

If there are exceptional circumstances that need to be considered when placing a student, parents will need to put the exceptional circumstances in writing and forward these to me by Monday 21 November 2016. It is important your concerns are **submitted every year** as circumstances change from year to year. Requests from previous years will not be looked at. These requests will then be reviewed by myself and the Learning Support Team. Please do not send requests to class teachers, or to myself asking for specific teachers for your child, as it would not be appropriate or equitable for us to accommodate these requests. All letters need to be sent directly to me.
