#### Classes for 2017

As is the normal pattern for our school, a great deal happens over the school holidays, much of which is unexpected. Your advice is crucial at the start of the new school year if your family circumstances change. All 2017 Year 1 – Year 6 students will return on **Monday 30 January** and remain in their 2016 class group and if possible with their 2016 class teacher for 'Holding Pattern' for the first few days of school. The class name retains the teacher's initial and the year is changed. For instance, class 2J would become 3J and 5N would become 6N, etc. for our Holding Pattern. During 'Holding Pattern', students will review class and school routines and we will do our utmost to ensure your child has a settled return to school.

Our Kindergarten classes commence on **Thursday 2 February.** Once our numbers are confirmed, we hope to move all other students in Years 1 to 6 as quickly as possible into their new classes with their new teachers. Student numbers have a tremendous impact on staffing and the number of classes in the school. We continue to seek your understanding in these circumstances.

#### Monday 30 January 2017

For the first day back next year, the following procedure will operate. When Year 1 – 6 students arrive at school, they proceed to the Courtyard and assemble in their old class line area. At 8:55 am, our usual morning assembly will occur and then students will move to their 'Holding Pattern' classroom. New students starting at Kariong Public School will wait at the office and then be escorted to their classroom at 9:15 am. In the afternoon at 2:55 pm students who are in Years 1 to 3 will be dismissed from their last year's dismissal area.

## Changes to Student Medication at School

From the beginning of 2017 there will be changes to the personal medications kept for students in the school sickbay.

It is a requirement of the NSW Department of Education that only medications, prescribed by a medical practitioner, can be administered by the school. All prescribed medication MUST be in its original packaging and must not show signs of being opened or tampered with.



The only allowable exception to this is Webster packaging. This is provided for a small charge from most chemists and is worth considering for children who require a weeks' worth of prescribed medication. It comes to us fully sealed and labelled by the pharmacist, with the contents and dosage required.

Over the counter medications such as Ventolin inhalers, Antihistamines etc. are permitted if they are prescribed by a Doctor and supported by ASCIA plans for your child for asthma and allergic/anaphylactic reactions.

Child medications kept currently at the school, that are not prescribed or belong to a child leaving us at the end of this year, are available to be picked up from the office by the child's parents **ONLY**.
