Classes for 2019

During the coming weeks, staff will be looking at the formation of classes for 2018. The placing of children into their new classes each year is a complex process. Classes at Kariong Public School are not graded academically and each year we strive to ensure that we have well balanced classes. The following factors are considered:

Gender, Academic ability, Language needs, Medical needs, Cultural background, and Behavioural needs

When this has occurred, we try to ensure that each child has at least one friend in their new class. Later in the Term, children will be asked to nominate five (5) children from their grade who they would like to be placed with. The school will try to place each student with at least one of these children. This does not mean they will be placed with their best or closest friends or with their group of friends. In fact, often this is not appropriate.

If there are exceptional circumstances that need to be considered when placing a student, parents will need to put the exceptional circumstances in writing and forward these to me by Monday 26 November 2018. It is important that your concerns are **submitted every year** as circumstances can change from year to year. Requests from previous years will not be looked at. These requests will then be reviewed by Mrs Skinner, myself and the Learning Support Team. Please do not send requests to class teachers, Mrs Skinner or myself asking for specific teachers for your child, as it would not be appropriate or equitable for us to accommodate these requests. All letters need to be sent directly to Mrs Skinner.

TECHNOLOGY NEWS

During Education Week in Term 3 parents were asked to complete a short survey about Kariong Public School's Information Communication and Technology (ICT). Here are the results of the survey.



There was an extremely high return of surveys with 237 surveys returned. The majority (38%) of responses were from parents and carers of children in Years 1 and 2.

64% parents said that digital technologies and ICT were either extremely important (28%)

or very important (36%) to their child's learning.

(27% =Important)



31% of parents reported that their child/children used a computer or tablet to help with their school work at home every day or almost every day and 30% once or twice a week.

A very high majority (98%) of parents said that their child/children had access to the Internet at home.

92% of parents reported that their child/children used either a laptop, iPad or tablet at home closely followed by a smartphone (53%) and a video gaming device (47%).


66% of parents thought that their child enjoyed using ICT to help them to learn.

76% parents were not aware of our school's new ICT Scope and Sequence for students.

71% of parents were not quite sure that Kariong PS had a clear sense of direction in how to use ICT to enhance the learning of students. 69% of parents were not quite sure that Kariong PS provided enough ICT opportunities for their child/children.

58% of parents answered 'Yes' to the question about introducing Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) to school and 28% needed more information about BYOD.

Supportive of BYOD in Years 5 & 6 (n=165)



Parents suggested that our school could provide more information/communication to parents about technology as well as teach more coding to our students.

Next Steps

Digital Technologies and ICT are integral parts of everyday teaching and learning at Kariong Public School.



All teaching and learning spaces (including the library, STEM room, Computer lab and tiered learning classroom) have an Interactive Whiteboard with Internet connectivity.

ICT Scope and Sequence

All teachers use the school's ICT Scope and Sequence to ensure that technology skills are introduced and reinforced from K-6. In addition our school will continue to have two specialist teachers who explicitly teach technology skills to our students in the Computer Lab and in the Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) room.

We have been recently publishing sections of our school's ICT Scope and Sequence in the school newsletter. Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

One of our school's key improvement strategies in our 2018-2020 Strategic Plan is to develop students' knowledge and understandings of technologies to enable them to respond innovatively to future challenges and needs.

NSW Department of Education schools can allow students to bring devices to school for the purpose of learning. The term "device" refers to any mobile electronic technology, including assistive technologies, brought into the school, which is owned by the student, and which has the capability of connecting to the department's Wi-Fi network.

During 2019 we will be developing a Kariong Public School Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) policy and program so that students in Years 5 and 6 will have the option to bring their own device to school in 2020. The BYOD program at Kariong Public School will be an optional program, therefore participation is not compulsory. If a student does not bring a device to school, they will have access to shared school owned devices and will fully participate in all classroom activities at school. The aim of the BYOD program is to cater to the parents and students within the school who would like a BYOD option to be available.

Information sessions for parents of Year 4 and 5 students will be held throughout 2019 to discuss device requirements, student responsibilities, access to free student software and other considerations related to the implementation of a BYOD policy.

Parent Technology Workshops

During 2019 staff plan to hold workshops for interested parents about our school technology including 'Our school's ICT Scope and Sequence' and 'Teaching Coding to Students'. These workshops will be advertised in the school newsletter and on our school Facebook page.
