#### Library update

Work on the new roof and guttering on our library has begun. The students loved seeing the crane here delivering all the roofing materials during the week and we hope to have all work completed in the next 2 weeks. Our students are enjoying library lessons in their classrooms, and I would like to thank Mr Brown for his wonderful organisation and patience as his workplace is under construction. Please take care when entering the school via Langford Drive gates as scaffolding and fencing has restricted a lot of this area.

#### **P&C** meeting

Last Monday evening we had our monthly meeting. This month we concentrated on how to spend the money raised via the Colour Run.

Our SRC representatives have had many meetings and our students came up with the following ideas which have in turn been supported by the P&C. Literacy and Numeracy resources will be purchased in each classroom, soccer goals and more equipment such as balls and outdoor games have already been purchased and our K-1 play area will have some themed cubby houses built in the bottom playground.

These items will be lots of fun for the students to enjoy, especially the outdoor activities. These initiatives hope to be all completed by the end of this term.

### **Sustainability and Biodiversity Project**

This year our school was successful in gaining a NSW Government Sustainable Schools Grant of \$14 965. The goals of this initiative include developing an outdoor learning area at the side of the oval, enhancing curriculum content and delivery to engage students and supporting the biodiversity of our school environment. Rumbalara Environmental Education Centre is supporting us with our project. This term Stage 2 and 3 students will be involved in producing and sharing digital documentaries highlighting the biodiversity of our school.


