NAISDA Dance College is Australia's leading arts training organisation providing nationally accredited qualifications specifically for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people.

The innovative program, Dance2Kinnect, uses dance to connect Aboriginal students to culture. Cultural dance has been an important part of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures for centuries. It is a way to connect people to their ancestors, land and culture.

Through the physicality of Indigenous dance and its deeper connection to culture, the Dance2Kinnect program will build Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children's self-esteem, social and emotional wellbeing and physical fitness, cultural identity and connection.

The school would work with qualified teachers from the Conservatorium and hold weekly lessons and rehearsals here at school.
