<b>Title</b>	Swimming Carnival
<b>Brief Description</b>	Swimming Carnival for all students in years 3-6 and children in year 2 who are turning 8 this year.
<b>Venue</b>	Peninsula Leisure Centre Woy Woy
<b>Day and Date</b>	Monday 17 <sup>th</sup> February 2020
<b>Cost</b>	\$10 includes travel on bus and pool entry \$5 pool entry only (The cost of the pool entry also covers equipment hire) Parent Spectators \$ 3.70
<b>Time of departure and return</b>	Leaving school by bus at 9:15am Returning to school by bus at 2pm
<b>Transport</b>	Travel will be by bus. It is optional for parents to drive their child to the pool.
<b>Events</b>	These will be run according to the following divisions set down by the NSWPSA: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 50m Freestyle - in individual age groups.</li><li>• Butterfly, Backstroke and Breaststroke events - in Junior, 11 Years and Senior age divisions:</li><li>• Junior 8, 9, 10 year olds</li><li>• 11 Years 11 year olds</li><li>• Senior 12 &amp; 13 year olds</li><li>• Individual Medley - in Junior (8, 9 &amp; 10) and Senior (11, 12 &amp; 13) age groups only</li><li>• 100m Freestyle - in an 'all age' divisions.</li></ul>
<b>Attendance</b>	All students in Years 3 to 6 are expected to attend the Swimming Carnival (even if they are not competing). Students in Year 2 who turn 8 this year and are competing in a competitive event are eligible to attend. When children are not in an event, they are to sit in the stands and are not permitted to swim in the baby pool. Children are expected to stay at the carnival until it concludes to support their house.
<b>Accompanying staff</b>	All 3-6 teachers
<b>Staff member with CPR training &amp; emergency care training</b>	All attending teaching staff
<b>Dress requirements</b>	Students should dress in their house colours. They may have their swimming costumes underneath or may change into them at the pool.
<b>Refreshment requirements</b>	Students will be required to bring their recess, lunch, a drink and a towel. (No glass containers are to be brought into the pool)
<b>Special requirements</b>	Entry Form – Please see separate entry form note for further information. <b>This must be completed in order for your child to be eligible to compete in the carnival.</b> All entries and results are recorded electronically, therefore, it is important for all entry forms to be returned by <b>Wednesday 12 February 2020</b> . No late entries will be accepted.
<b>Important information</b>	We will be running non-competitive events in the smaller pool for those students in Years 3-6 who are unable to compete in the competitive races. Students will have the opportunity to attempt a variety of strokes in the smaller pool where they are able to stand if required. Please sign the permission note and tick the correct box on the entry form if your child wishes to participate in the non-competitive events. <b>PLEASE NOTE:</b> Your child must be able to swim 25 metres to participate in any event on the day. If your child is competing in the competitive races (50m), they are NOT eligible to participate in the non-competitive events.
