Brief Description	<p>Year 6 students have the opportunity to participate in an educational excursion of the National Capital commencing Monday 23 March and concluding on Wednesday 25 March. Students will participate in a variety of educational programs which focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy.</p> <p>The excursion will depart from school on Monday 23 March at 6am SHARP and return to the school on Wednesday 25 March at approximately 5:30pm. Travel will be by coach and the cost for the excursion is \$330 per student.</p> <p>A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is due by Monday 24 February 2020. Payment options include online at our school website or by cash or EFTPOS at the school office or phoning 4340 1885. All payments are receipted; please keep all receipts as they are your proof of payment. If paying by instalments please adhere to the instalment dates. Please contact the school if you would like to arrange an alternative payment plan.</p>
