On Monday 16 March the Department of Education issued operational guidelines for all Department of Education schools.

Social distancing

A phased social distancing strategy will be implemented from today, Monday 16 March 2020, to support ongoing school and corporate operations. In the first phase of its social distancing strategy, the department will take a number of practical measures to support wider NSW Health containment strategies. Implementation at our school includes the following;

School assemblies

Our school will look at alternative ways to communicate with students and parents other than through school assemblies.

School excursions

All school excursions outside of our school's local community will be cancelled until further notice.

All major Arts, Sports and Initiative activities and events will temporarily be ceased until further notice. This includes whole school sporting events and inter-school events involving three or more schools.
