Lori Tickets



Students earn Lori Tickets in the playground and classroom for demonstrating our school expectations. At the end of the term, students have the opportunity to trade these tickets in for a reward at 'Lori Rewards Day'. These tickets are kept at school and are tracked by the classroom teacher and the student.

Bronze, Silver, Gold and Diamond Reward

All students will have the opportunity to earn daily points to achieve Bronze, Silver, Gold and Diamond level. This program is designed to recognise and reward students who consistently uphold our core values and expectations. Students who display ALL of the school's three core values: RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY and PERSONAL BEST will be awarded with 1 PBL point daily starting in week 3, Monday 7th February.

Bronze 50 Points Certificate	Silver 100 Points Certificate	Gold 150 Points Certificate and wristband	Diamond 175 Points Certificate, pin and special reward
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Each student's reward points will be tracked using a free online system called 'ClassDojo'. Parents will be able to access this online system to view their child's points. **Dojo will only be used for tracking PBL points.**
