







Sport in Schools Australia (SISA) -Term 2

Dear Parents.

Starting on Monday, May 2, the students in the following classes: KG, KW, KM, 1J, 1T, 1G and 1/2FM are invited to participate in a gymnastics program provided by the Sport in Schools Australia Company (SISA). This program is not compulsory and students not participating will be provided with another sport option during this time.

The cost for the term (8 weeks of lessons) will be \$20.00 per student. This program is provided at a significantly reduced cost due to being subsidized by a government grant. If you have fees in advance from 2021, please ring the front office to use these funds.

Gymnastics Program

The SISA Gymnastics Program teaches each stage of learning according to individual ability and syllabus outcome requirements. The program is delivered in sequential steps, to allow children of all levels of skill and fitness to participate safely and achieve their personal best.

The program is based on the recreational gymnastics theme, designed to provide a fun, and challenging environment that is fundamental for a child's growth and development.

How is it organised?

The program is delivered in a range of complex stations that allow sequential skill development of all dominant movement patterns. With a large range of resources (provided by SISA), we have a strong focus on high engagement levels throughout our programs, ensuring children obtain the maximum benefit and enjoyment from each weekly session.

The SISA team include a diverse range of specialised teachers and instructors, with the majority of their staff qualified PD/H/PE teachers and gymnastics certified coaches (including high performance coaches).

If you would like your child to attend these sessions, please complete the permission slip on the next page and make payment at the front office of \$20. If you would like to make payments via a plan, please see the front office staff. Please ensure that permission and payments are returned by **Friday April 29, 2022.**

In line with the 'School Positive Behaviour for Learning Program (PBL)' any child whose behaviour is deemed unsatisfactory will be withdrawn from this planned activity. This decision will be made by the Senior Executive after referral from the organising/class teacher. Parents and students will be informed if attendance is refused.
